## NOTE:

The Sacramento-Yolo Port District was established in 1947 and the Port (known as the Port of Sacramento until 2009) opened in 1963.

In December 2005, the Port entered into a contractual agreement with the City of West Sacramento for the City to manage and operate the Port. Through CA legislation (AB 2939) the make-up of the Sacramento Yolo Port District was changed from the Commission comprising of seven regional members to the current model of one Yolo County Supervisor and four representatives from the City of West Sacramento, appointed by the Mayor. Essentially, the legislation removed the port from the jurisdiction of Sacramento County/City, leaving primary governance to the City of West Sacramento and Yolo County.

The district only has eminent domain within the boundaries of West Sacramento. Areas of Yolo and Sacramento County must receive those counties agencies' approval to intervene with services within the respective counties.
