Dear Elkhorn landowner:

On April 23, 2026, the Yolo Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) adopted Resolution No. 2026-01 approving the Elkhorn Fire Protection District (FPD) and County Service Area 9 (CSA 9) Reorganization into the Springlake FPD (LAFCo Application #24-02). Following the meeting, Staff mailed notice of the protest hearing and a protest form to registered voters and landowners in the affected area.

Recently, LAFCo staff discovered that the landowner mailing list for the Elkhorn FPD affected area was incomplete. This means some landowners did not receive the notice of the protest hearing as required. To correct this error, staff is mailing the notice and protest form to all Elkhorn FPD landowners and **extending the protest deadline to June 16, 2026**. This ensures every landowner receives the required 21-day notice period.

The protest hearing listed in the attached notice will still occur on Tuesday, May 26, 2026, as noted. However, instead of closing that day, the hearing will be carried over to another hearing on June 16, 2026 at 5:30 p.m. at the Elkhorn Fire Station. **Written protests must be filed with LAFCo before the hearing closes on June 16, 2026 at 5:30 p.m.**

In the days following the protest hearing, staff will tally the protests and report the results to LAFCo on June 25, 2026 at 9:00 a.m., where the Commission will certify the protest results.

If you have already submitted a protest, you do not need to submit another one. The protest process is still open; we are only extending the deadline by 21 days to ensure all landowners receive proper notice.
